AFFIDAVIT MAY BE USED WITH *IN PROGRESS* INSPECTION FOR RE-ROOFS

The affidavit does not take the place of the required dry-in inspection, but can be used in conjunction with the inspection. The primary purpose of the In-Progress Inspection is to protect the existing house contents, and interior finish from potential damage due to rain. The contractor is required to call the inspection on the day it will be ready, and the inspector will make an In-Progress Inspection of the dry-in, and accept the affidavit for the portion of the roof already covered. This affidavit can only be used for re-roof and is not applicable to new construction or tile roofs.
