**MINUTES**

**I. Call To Order**

Call to order at 10:15 A.M by Chairman Lombardi.

**II. Roll Call**

Chairman Lombardi, Ken Webster, Jesse Beall, William Dreggors, and Tom Pierce were all present.

Attending: Anita Gonzalez, City Planning Administrator.

**III. Approval of Minutes**

Minutes of the November 8, 2004 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as presented. The motion for adoption was made by Mr. Webster and seconded by Mr. Beall. The motion passed unanimously.

**IV. Continued Items**

1. Cataloguing of historical data

Workshop set for January 17<sup>th</sup> is Martin Luther King Day. It must be rescheduled. February 7<sup>th</sup> was chosen as the workshop date at 10: 00 A.M.

2. Status of Short Term Goal – Video sales at City Hall (Mr. Dreggors)

Mr. Dreggors reports that his recording equipment broke and is being replaced. He hopes to have some copies ready soon.

## **V. New Business**

### 1. Rescheduling of January 17, 2005 Workshop

The meeting is set for February 7<sup>th</sup> 10:00 A.M. Mr. Webster discussed the need to make a decision on cataloging the data. It was decided to use the same system as the County.

### 2. Verbal Public Presentations by Mr. Beall and Mr. Dreggors

An oral presentation is to be made at the library January 12<sup>th</sup> by Mr. Dreggors at 10:00 to 11:00 A.M. and Jesse Beall from 11:00 to 12 Noon.

### 3. Creation of a DeBary Historic Calendar for 2006

Chairman Lombardi suggests a contest to get the public to submit historical pictures. Ms. Gonzalez suggests a request for funding to the City Council concurrently with the contest. Chairman Lombardi notes that the City will fund the calendar, it will not be for sale. There should be a limit of one calendar per DeBary family. Mr. Pierce made the motion to approve; Mr. Webster seconded it. All members voted to approve.

### 4. Report on presentation to City Council by Chairman Lombardi

Anita Gonzalez reported Mr. Lombardi explained to the Council which projects the board had undertaken since April of last year and the accomplishments to date. He also presented what the board wanted to do in the future.

The Council was very receptive to the report.

Mr. Lombardi asked Mr. Dreggors to comment on the County's historical display. Mr. Dreggors reports it is a display of pictures through Leisure Services. It will be a traveling exhibit to the cities. Nancy Maddox at Leisure Services is the contact person. She can be reached at 736-5953. It was suggested that the library would be the place for the display in DeBary. Also, it was noted the library hours have been expanded.

## **VI. Staff Items**

### 1. Display Case status

Anita Gonzalez reports it has been ordered and the delivery date is January 21<sup>st</sup>. It should be here for the next workshop. The case is made of wood; it has a light and a glass back. It should look lovely to display artifacts. It is 6 feet tall and would be displayed at the entrance to the building.

Ms. Gonzalez asks the committee to refer to a newspaper article she included in their packets. She notes it concerns UCF's interest in Deltona's historical data. She asks if they are interested in contacting UCF to include DeBary information in their collection.

The board suggests inviting Mr. Martin Williams and Dr. Rubin White (UCF) to attend the next historic preservation board meeting. Ms. Gonzalez suggests Jessie Beal and Mr. Dreggors contact them as they are collecting an oral history. Chairman Lombardi asks if Mrs. Margaret Oglesby would be willing to attend as he found her very interesting. It was decided a letter would be sent inviting them to the next meeting in April.

Ms. Gonzalez reports the Oglesby land was a joint County and City purchase and that there will be a management plan for the use of the property. It will contain plans for preserving archeological sites on the property. It will be a passive park possibly with features like a fishing pier, a canoe launch, trails and a parking lot.
