MINUTES

I. Call to Order

Chairman Lombardi called the meeting to order at 10:17 a.m.

II. Roll Call

Present: Gerald Lombardi, Kenneth Webster, Warren Graham, and Jesse Beall.

Also Present: Planning Administrator Anita Gonzalez

III. Approval of Minutes

- **Minutes of November 13, 2006 Regular Meeting**

Motion for approval of the minutes as submitted was made by Mr. Graham and seconded by Mr. Webster. The motion passed unanimously.

IV. New Business

- Set Workshop Dates for Remainder of the Year

Chairman Lombardi reminded the Board of the dates for the remaining regular quarterly meetings for the year, and stated that they could hold workshops immediately following the regular meetings. In addition, the Board scheduled workshops for April 16th and October 15th from 9:30 – 11:30 a.m.

- Historic Presentation Speaker for Spring Event

Mr. Graham suggested that Julie Schofield, with Volusia County Historic Preservation, might be a good speaker. He also mentioned Mr. Cadwell, but noted that he is primarily familiar with the east side of the County. The Board discussed that the event should be held in the early evening to attract a larger audience. Ms. Gonzalez suggested that the Board invite Ronald Williamson from the News Journal.

The Board asked Ms. Gonzalez to look at the last half of April and the first half of May to establish available dates to hold the event at Town Hall. The Board decided to meet on February 27th at 10:00 a.m. to finalize the plans for the event. The members discussed providing notices to the public schools, posting it on the City website, and possibly publishing it in the City newsletter.

V. Discussion Items

- City Naming for Oglesby and Gardella Properties
- Scenic Highway Designation – River of Lakes Heritage Corridor

Chairman Lombardi stated that DeBary would be either the beginning or the end of the Heritage Corridor, and the City should tie in the new park with the Corridor. He added that a possible name for the park might be “River of Lakes Community Park”. Ms. Gonzalez informed the Board that the deadline for submitting possible names for the new park is February 28th. Mr. Beall recommended naming the park after a DeBary resident.

Chairman Lombardi asked Ms. Gonzalez to write a cover letter to the Council on behalf of the Committee recommending that they have a presentation regarding the Heritage Corridor and they consider participating in the program.
