**MINUTES**

**I.     Call to Order**

Chairman Lombardi called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Graham moved to approve all four sets of minutes. Mr. Webster seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**IV.    Old Business**

- Report & Critique of Spring Event

Chairman Lombardi said it was poorly attended, but it was a good presentation. He suggested that next time the Committee might begin the process earlier so that it could be advertised in the newsletter. Mr. Graham asked if the presentation could be recorded and posted to the City website. Ms. Goerner suggested making a recording of the event to distribute to the local schools to get the children interested.

Chairman Lombardi said both speakers would be willing to return in the future.

- Reaffirm Workshop Dates

Chairman Lombardi announced the remaining workshop dates for the year.

**V.     New Business**

- Schedule Special Cataloging Workshop for New Member

The workshop was scheduled for July 9<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Webster suggested having a display at National Night Out on August 7<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Graham said they could put something together at the workshop on July 9<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Webster made a motion to inform Safety Coordinator Alan Williamson that the HPAB would like to participate in National Night Out. Mr. Graham seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Lombardi stated that the City Manager has authorized the Board to purchase a plaque to place on the building where Redman's Barber Shop was for many years. Mr. Graham said that the business is now closed after 55 years, and the building owner has agreed to leave the barber pole there, and the Board could install a plaque next to the pole. Chairman Lombardi added that it would be a good idea to budget for plaques on other buildings in the future such as the Civic Center, the fire department, the old library building, and 4B'S Restaurant.

Mr. Graham made a motion to place a plaque on the building honoring Redman's Barber Shop with a ceremony when the plaque is placed on the wall. Ms. Goerner seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Graham said he would obtain an estimate on the plaque and that they might purchase one made of aluminum that looks like bronze at about half the cost.

Chairman Lombardi spoke about the Activity Book that was previously done by the City, and the Board updating it. He said that he would like to merge the Activity Book and the Semi-Centennial into one document. Mr. Beall said the documents were originally completed by Bob Mauney.

Chairman Lombardi asked Ms. Tebo to ensure a thank-you letter is sent by the City to the lady in California that donated the old scrapbooks.

Mr. Beall stated that the City should place a plaque by Highway 3, which was called Shell Road. Chairman Lombardi asked Mr. Graham to check with his contacts on the Volusia County Historical Board how to go about recognizing a historic road.
