Over the past several weeks, many residents throughout the area have had their belongings removed from their cars during the night. In almost 100% of these cases, the cars were left unlocked by their owners.

The thieves walk the streets in the middle of the night and pull on the door handles of the cars on the streets and in the driveways. If a car door opens, they enter the car and take everything that they can find and carry.

The City of DeBary's extremely low crime rate does not mean you should ignore safety. Be sure to secure your home and vehicles at all times. **LOCK YOUR CAR.** Don't leave expensive valuables in plain view in your vehicles, because they are just an invitation to the bad guys. **Remember, "IT CAN HAPPEN HERE."**

Floridians can now report dog or other organized animal fighting. Legitimate tips will be eligible for a reward of up to \$5,000 by calling The Humane Society of the United States' animal fighting toll-free tip hotline at 1-877-TIP-HSUS (1-877-847-4787). Callers can remain anonymous. For local reporting, call Volusia Animal Control at (386) 740-5241 weekdays from 8 AM to 5 PM or the Volusia Sheriff's Office at (386) 736-5999 – Open 24/7. County licenses for your pets may be purchased at your vet's office, County Administrative Office on Enterprise Road, and DeBary City Hall.

Use of Rights-of-Way in the City of DeBary

A Right-of-way is the land which a state, county, or city owns or has an easement devoted to or required for use as a transportation facility, i.e., bus shelter or for use as a street.

Right-of-way line shall mean the boundary line which defines the area of the right-of-way.

Therefore, this area of land, known as a right-of-way, is set aside for the use of only transportation facility or street use. This means that structures, traffic obstacles, or anything permanent cannot be constructed in this area by the public.

The Only Exception is the right of the public to have a mailbox located in this area, on an approved mailbox stand, (see DeBary Land Development Code, Sec 4-138 (g) *Mailboxes and newspaper delivery boxes*. The locations and construction of mailboxes, newspaper delivery boxes and similar structures shall be in accordance with the latest edition of "A Guide for Erecting Mail Boxes on Highways" by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO). Any such existing structure not in conformance with this section may be required to be made to conform with this section if the City Traffic Engineer determines such existing structure to be a traffic hazard.

Landscaping in this area is also subject to site distances, heights, and is at the discretion of the owner, which is a state, county, or city. Please contact the City at (386) 668-2040 if you have questions concerning right-of-way issues.
