Sorry, computers and televisions cannot be accepted. This event is for residential purposes only; **NO BUSINESS DUMPING** will be permitted. CALL THE APPOINTMENT LINE AT (386) 626-6643 TO QUALIFY

Volusia County's Pet Vet Cruiser is a state-of-the-art mobile veterinary clinic for pet owners, who qualify, to have their pets surgically sterilized. Pet Vet Cruiser follows the income requirements for the Florida Free Lunch program in use by public school systems in Florida and other community services to determine for which program an individual qualifies. Residents must show proof at the check-in desk on surgery day.

A rabies vaccination will be given and a license issued for each animal that is not currently vaccinated and licensed. Proof of vaccination must be shown at the time of surgery if an animal is currently vaccinated.

Pet surgeries are performed in the morning. Drop off for pets is at 9 AM. Pets will be released to their owners the same afternoon. Call the appointment line at 626-6643 to schedule; this is a Deland number. Call-in times are between 10 AM to 3 PM Mondays through Fridays.

When you call, please have the following information ready: Name, address, phone numbers, total household income, pet(s) name, sex, breed, color, age, weight and any allergy and/or vaccination history. If your pet does not have a current rabies vaccination, the cost is \$5.00 for a vaccination and a County of Volusia license.

You can register your phone number to be notified of a local Emergency.

To be alerted by phone of an emergency situation, please call DeBary Safety Coordinator Alan Williamson at (386) 668-2040 ext. 323 to have your telephone number added to the call list. TO ALL PET OWNERS

To all pet owners, please secure your pets. If your pet has gone missing, you may call Volusia County Animal Control at (386) 740-5241. Your pet may have been taken to the Southeast Humane Society located at 1200 S. Glencoe Road, New Smyrna Beach, Florida 32168. (386) 428-9860. To report a lost or found animal, contact AKC-CAR by dialing 1-800-252-7894. Responsible Pet Care is to Spay/Neuter, Vaccinate, and Insert a Microchip.

The insertion of a microchip is quick and painless. The chip is read by a scanner and matched to the owner or the designated contact for the return of a pet to its owner. Your veterinarian will provide you with an American Kennel Club-Companion Animal Recovery (AKC-CAR) program enrollment form. Always make sure that your contact information is current. Keeping the AKC-CAR program updated as to your whereabouts is absolutely essential in the event your pet becomes lost.
