I. Call to Order

Chair Mary Hall called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

III. Approval of Minutes - Regular Meeting held March 14, 2006

- Safety Light Bars on City Vehicles

Mr. Williamson informed the Committee that the safety t-bars and strobe lights have been installed on all three City vehicles. He added that there are also first aid kits in each vehicle.

- DeBary Cleanup Day

Mr. Leighton voiced the need for additional volunteers to participate in the DeBary Cleanup Day. Mr. Williamson said he submitted a request to Deland High School and Deltona High School for juniors and seniors to participate in the event.

Chair Hall asked if they could contact the Sheriff's Department to have individuals doing community service hours help during the event. Mr. Williamson responded that he would speak to Captain Osowski.

John Harvey stated that he asked the Council members to attend Cleanup Day at the last City Council meeting. He said he would like to ask people for their driver's licenses to ensure that only DeBary residents are participating. Mr. Williamson stated that because it is also Amnesty Day, they could not turn away County residents disposing of hazardous materials. He added that

he could compile a list of the other cities holding similar events to distribute to non-residents wanting to dispose of anything other than hazardous materials.

Mr. McMahon suggested holding the meetings bi-monthly over the summer. The Committee decided to discuss the suggestion at the next meeting when all the members are present.
