MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Chairman Graham called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Roll Call

Present: Chairman Warren Graham, Mac McShea, Pat Gunter, Jack Lenzen, George Coleman, and Norm Erickson

Absent: Susan Preil

Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez and City Manager Maryann Courson

3. Approval of Minutes

- **Meeting of November 7, 2005**

Chairman Graham entertained a motion to approve the minutes of November 7, 2005. Motion made by Mr. Coleman and seconded by Mr. Lenzen. The motion carried unanimously.

4. FDOT Fence (Community Bank)

Mr. Gonzalez explained the various plans for the fence to the Committee, and noted that the second page is for the landscaping. He stated that he is concerned with installing a fountain at this time, but said that Dave Wickham, Landscape Architect for the City, will continue to research options for a fountain. The Committee discussed the various fence options provided by Mr. Wickham.

Mr. Gonzalez asked the Committee if they would like quotes for black vinyl on three sides with the picket in the front. Chairman Graham answered that would be his preference. Mr. Gonzalez asked about the lift station. Mr. McShea responded that he would like to see the vinyl surrounding it. Chairman Graham said he would like the picket. Mr. Erickson said whatever they chose should match the front. The Committee decided they would like to see a price for alternate #3. Mr. Gonzalez said that he would ask Mr. Wickham for an estimate on the landscaping.

5. 17/92 Streetscape Update

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that the City is wrapping up its dealings with Dora Landscaping. He stated that the palm fronds would be cut down at 8 a.m. on Friday, and the rain sensors have been installed.

Mr. Gonzalez explained the drawings for the signage to the Committee. He said he would ask the architect for updated construction costs for the signage. He asked the Committee if they would like to have the riverboat theme on the signage. Mrs. Gunter made a motion to approve the sign without the riverboat and include the word “welcome”. Mr. Lenzen seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Gonzalez discussed the pots with the Committee. Chairman Graham said he was still interested in showcasing an intersection with mature plantings. Ms. Courson informed the Committee that Council Member Fulton volunteered to showcase a planter at his intersection at his own expense. She also stated that she has received suggestions for an adopt-a-planter program. Mrs. Gunter said that they could have a contest, as well.

6. Public Participation

Marie Rafferty, resident of Parkview Heights, said that she is disappointed that the south end of 17-92 seems to be left out as far as lights, trees, Christmas decorations, pots, etc. The Committee agreed with Ms. Rafferty, and said they would like to take the decorations down to Dirksen Drive as the budget allows. Chairman Graham pointed out that the plantings in the median were started at the south end of town.

Ms. Courson said that she would like the Committee to make a presentation at the January meeting, and she would like to move ahead with the adopt-a-planter program so that it can be put in the newsletter. Chairman Graham said that he would make the presentation to Council on January 4th.

Chairman Graham noted that both Mr. Lenzen and Mr. Coleman resigned.

7. Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
