MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Chairman Graham called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Roll Call

Present: Chairman Warren Graham, Mac McShea, Pat Gunter, and Susan Preil

Absent: Norm Erickson

Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez and City Manager Maryann Courson

3. Approval of Minutes

- **Meeting of December 13, 2005**

Chairman Graham entertained a motion to approve the minutes of December 13, 2005. Motion made by Mr. McShea and seconded by Ms. Preil. The motion carried unanimously.

4. FDOT Fence (Community Bank)

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that he came up with a preliminary cost between \$40,000 and \$42,000 for the project. He said he spoke with Mr. Englert, president of First Community Bank, and the bank is willing to partially fund the project. Mr. McShea stated that he had been working with Volusia County to have some of the plants donated, and FDOT would be providing the shrubbery in the front.

5. Adopt-a-Planter Program

Chairman Graham said that Council Member Fulton adopted the first planter. Mrs. Gunter stated that she would be doing one, as well. Chairman Graham said he had received a couple of inquiries from others interested in participating. He asked Mr. Gonzalez if it is possible to move them, as they are full of dirt. Mr. Gonzalez answered that they would need some heavy equipment, but they could be moved. Mr. McShea recommended the use of native plants. Mrs. Gunter suggested presenting the program to various civic organizations.

Ms. Preil recommended that the Committee set parameters to ensure that nothing invasive or too big is planted that might block signage. Mr. Gonzalez asked Ms. Preil if she could compile a list of acceptable plants. Mr. McShea suggested that they ask a few of the master gardeners in the City for a list or consult with DeBary Nursery. Chairman Graham asked if the Committee could invite them to Town Hall for a workshop in two weeks. The other members agreed and the workshop was scheduled for Tuesday, January 24th at 5:30 p.m.

Mr. McShea informed the Committee that he has been speaking with Steve Kitner of Volusia County to establish a partnership for a nursery on the extra acreage at the borrow pit.
