**MINUTES**

**1.    Call to Order**

Chairman Graham called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

**2.    Roll Call**

Present: Chairman Warren Graham, Mac McShea, Pat Gunter, Barbara Rutz, and Susan Preil

Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

**3.    Approval of Minutes**

- **Meeting of April 11, 2006**

Chairman Graham asked if there were any changes or corrections to the minutes of April 11, 2006. Mrs. Gunter made a motion to approve, and Mr. McShea seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**4.    Update on FDOT Fence (Community Bank)**

Mr. Gonzalez updated the Committee on the planters. He said that he is working with the contractor to address the irrigation on the planters, and that Servello will be watering them more frequently. He stated that he would have the equipment to move the planters on Wednesday to Dirksen and 17-92 if the Committee desired him to do so. The Committee discussed new locations for the five planters. Mrs. Gunter said she would ask Volusia County if they would like to place two planters on the DeBary Hall site. Mr. McShea suggested placing two planters at the Butterfly Garden. The Committee decided to place two at the Mansion, two at the VFW, and one at the Butterfly Garden.

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that everything is ready for the FDOT fence, and he would be preparing an agenda item for Council review very soon.

**5. City Entrance Signage**

Mr. Gonzalez said that DOT has given their approval and requested sealed drawings for the two signs at Lake Monroe Park and Dirksen Drive; that due to the retention pond and the Ford property, they would not be installing the sign on Enterprise Road at this time; that they would be using the small signs at the two locations; and that he would be preparing a bid package soon.

**6. Public Participation**

Mr. McShea suggested installing posts similar to those at the DeBary Manor in front of the Winn Dixie plaza for the attachment of banners advertising community events. There was a brief discussion regarding banners on 17-92.

**7. Adjournment**

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
