MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Chairman Graham called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. Roll Call

Present: Chairman Warren Graham, Mac McShea, Pat Gunter, Dennis Munsey and Barbara Rutz

Absent: Susan Preil

Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

3. Approval of Minutes

- **Meeting of June 13, 2006**

Chairman Graham asked if there were any changes or corrections to the minutes of June 13, 2006. Mr. McShea made a motion to approve, and Ms. Rutz seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Update on FDOT Fence (Community Bank)

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that the City is conducting further negotiations with DOT; that they will be asking for a variance; and are waiting on approval from DOT to move forward.

Mr. Gonzalez stated that a representative from John Deere would be conducting a demonstration at the Barwick property on July 17th at 10:00 a.m. for anyone interested in attending.

5. City Entrance Signage

Mr. Gonzalez said that the City conducted a pre-bid conference with one attendee; that there were six interested parties; that the bids are due to City Hall by 2:00 p.m. on July 14th; and that landscape and irrigation were deleted from the bid package.

6. Discussion of New Projects for FY 2006/2007

Mr. Gonzalez stated that the proposed budget would be \$75,000.

Mrs. Gunter suggested that bus stop covers be installed in the next fiscal year. She added that she would also like to see the removal of the suicide lanes from 17-92, the installation of medians, and the removal and replacement of non-compliant, outdated signage.

Ms. Rutz recommended that business owners install new landscaping to improve 17-92, and that older businesses provide adequate parking.

Mr. Munsey asked for more visible and decorative street signs to match the new lighting.

Mrs. Gunter noted that she had seen a scrolling marquee on a mast arm in another city recently. Chairman Graham stated that he would take a picture of it for the Committee.

Chairman Graham stated that signage was also on his list; that he would like to see the City put up flag decorations from Flag Day through July on the light poles; and that the easements need to be cleaned up on Highbanks Road in the Glen Abbey area. Mr. Gonzalez said he would check on the cost for the flag decorations.

Mr. McShea voiced his concern regarding weeds at the corner of Highbanks and Enterprise Roads. He also recommended a walkway across 17-92 during special events at Gateway Park

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that Progress Energy would begin installation in September on the streetlights from Plantation to Dirksen.

7. Public Participation

Mayor Coleman addressed several of the ideas proposed by the Committee and noted that the City has received a request for a sidewalk on Sunrise Boulevard to DeBary Hall.

8. Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
