MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Chairman Warren Graham called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

2. Roll Call

3. Approval of Minutes

- **Meeting of April 10, 2007**

Chairman Warren Graham asked if there were any changes or corrections to the minutes of April 10, 2007. Ms. Preil made a motion to approve, and Mr. McShea seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. City Entrance Signs

Mr. Gonzalez explained that Council considered the bid received for the two signs in August 2006, but did not award the bid at that time. He placed some pictures of the signage on the projector for the Committee. The members discussed the pictures and agreed that they did not like the boat shadow, but would prefer additional lettering in lieu of the shadowing.

The members discussed that they liked “Welcome to DeBary”, with “The River City” below. Ms. Clark suggested “DeBary Welcomes You to the River City”. Mr. Gonzalez said he would have both of the options prepared for the Committee.

5. Bus Stop Covers

Mr. Gonzalez informed the members that there are six bus stops in DeBary with a bench and a trash can. He provided pictures of different examples for the Committee to discuss. He asked the members to take pictures and note locations of any covers in neighboring cities or counties that they liked.

Mayor Coleman asked the Committee to keep safety in mind, as well as the numbers of people that would be sitting at the bus stops when deciding on the type of cover to use.

There was a brief discussion regarding the planters on 17-92, and Ms. Clark suggested that there be a contest for the best looking planter.

6. Public Participation

Ms. Clark informed the members that she would be out of town for the next meeting. Ms. Rutz said she might be out of town for a graduation.

7. Adjournment

Mr. McShea made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Clark seconded. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
