MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Chairman Warren Graham called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. Roll Call

Present: Warren Graham, Mac McShea, Carole Ollivier, Francine Eubanks, and Barbara Rutz

Absent: Laura Clark (excused) and Susan Preil (unexcused)

Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

3. Approval of Minutes

- **Meeting of May 8, 2007**

Chairman Warren Graham asked if there were any changes or corrections to the minutes of May 8, 2007. Mr. McShea made a motion to approve, and Ms. Rutz seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. City Entrance Signs

Mr. Gonzalez said he had spoke with the designer and there would not be a charge for changing the lettering on the signs. He added that the Council would begin budget discussions at the meeting June 20, 2007.

Mr. McShea stated that he believed the current city signs could be rehabilitated in lieu of purchasing new signs due to budgetary constraints. He added that the copy area could be redone without replacing the entire structure. Mr. McShea made a motion for the Committee to pursue the remodeling of the current city entrance signs and to revert the DeBary Hall sign back to a City of DeBary sign. Ms. Ollivier seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Gonzalez said he would submit the Committee's motion to Council for budget consideration.

5. Bus Stop Covers

Mr. Gonzalez asked if anyone had found any good examples in any other cities. The members responded that they had not. Mr. McShea recommended that they wait until Walgreens moves in at the corner of Highbanks and 17-92 to see if they might participate in the project.

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that the City had received an email suggesting that bicycle racks should be installed at the bus stops. He said that they range anywhere from \$100 to \$330 each, and that he would use \$250 as an estimate for each of the six stops in the City.

Ms. Ollivier suggested that the planters should be painted to make them more noticeable. There was a discussion regarding the planters, FDOT restrictions, and the appearance and maintenance of the planters.

6. Public Participation

Lenny Marks, 32 Wisteria Drive, said he thought that some of the planter locations were not appropriate. He suggested moving a few in front of the retention pond by Riverside Bank or next to the City entrance signs. Mr. Gonzalez said he would ask DOT if they would allow the City to place the planters in front of the pond.

7. Adjournment

Mr. McShea made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Rutz seconded. The meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
