MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Vice-Chair Mac McShea called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. Roll Call

Present: Mac McShea, Carole Ollivier, Barbara Rutz and Laura Clark

Absent: Susan Preil

Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

3. Approval of Minutes

- **Meeting of December 11, 2007**

Ms. Clark made a motion to approve, and Ms. Ollivier seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Election of Chair and Vice-Chair

Vice-Chair McShea moved that they postpone the item until the next meeting. Ms. Ollivier seconded and noted that she would be out of town for the next two meetings. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Project Update on Entrance Signs & Bus Stop

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that the bus stop has been completed and is located across from the library on 17-92 northbound.

Mr. Gonzalez updated the Committee on the entrance signs and stated that Fastsigns created the graphic; that the parks staff has come up with a color for the poles; that he would have to send it to Council for approval; and that staff estimated they would need approximately 830 feet of rope. He asked the Committee members their choice of color for the rope.

The Committee discussed colors thoroughly and decided that they did not wish to have a bright color. He asked the members to pick some colors so that he could have the samples painted on some wood for the Committee to see. The members agreed that they would like to see three

samples of the natural, white and blue colors. Mr. Gonzalez asked them to email him after they look at the samples to tell him which they prefer.

6. Adopt a Planter Program

Mr. Gonzalez said he sent letters to all the participants, and the majority have responded that they wish to continue. He added that there are five or six people on a waiting list.

Vice-Chair McShea said he would like to get a report on which ones are available. He suggested that with the new City Hall under construction, they might consider moving some of the planters to the site. He added that there would no longer be a need for the watering that is done by the parks department.

There was extensive discussion regarding Vice-Chair McShea's suggestion.

Mr. Gonzalez said he would determine the current cost for watering and the cost for moving the planters. Ms. Ollivier suggested using prisoners to move the planters.

7. Public Participation

Mayor Coleman spoke briefly about bus stop covers and the planters.

8. Adjournment

Ms. Rutz made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Clark seconded. The meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
