**MINUTES**

**1.    Call to Order**

Chair Mac McShea called the workshop to order at 5:30 pm.

**2.    Roll Call**

Present: Susan Preil, Mac McShea, Barbara Rutz, and Laura Clark  
Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

**3.    Discussion of Future Streetscape Projects**

Chair McShea stated that although the Committee does not have money in the budget, they should plan for future projects.

Chair McShea stated that all the newer subdivisions have signage, and he would like Plantation Estates to have a sign on 17-92 near DeBary Drive. The Committee discussed his suggestion. Ms. Preil said that she feels that a community association, rather than the City should handle it.

The Committee spoke about the need for signage on 17-92 near the new River City Nature Park at Barwick Road. Mr. Gonzalez stated that they also need signage for the new City Hall and Town Hall.

There was discussion regarding the installation of medians on 17-92 from Highbanks to Dirksen and the removal of the suicide lane.

Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that Ms. Ollivier moved back to Las Vegas, and they need to recruit someone to fill her position.

Ms. Preil discussed the mast arms and said that there should be a mast arm at Saxon and 17-92. Chair McShea noted that DeBary and Orange City share the intersection. Mr. Gonzalez informed the Committee that the City is currently working on a mast arm signal at Highbanks Road and 17-92.

Chair McShea voiced his desire for the southeast corner of Highbanks and Enterprise to be cleaned up. Mr. Gonzalez stated that the property has never been cleared, and code enforcement cannot force the owner to clear it. He suggested that Chair McShea speak with the owner, Mr. Ford.

Mr. Gonzalez clarified that the Committee wished to pursue a sign on 17-92 for the Nature Park, median installation on 17-92 from Dirksen to Highbanks, and bus stops. He asked the Committee to narrow down which bus stops they want to work on.

Mr. Gonzalez said that they should come up with some numbers for the bus stop structures by the next meeting to be ready for budget discussions. The Committee discussed the type of bus stop structure they would like and asked Mr. Gonzalez to get some prices for the next meeting.

Mr. Gonzalez updated the members on the planters.
