MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Chair Mac McShea called the workshop to order at 5:30 pm.

2. Roll Call

Present: Susan Preil, Mac McShea, Barbara Rutz, and Laura Clark
Also Present: Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

3. Approval of Minutes

- Meeting of April 8, 2008

Vice Chair Preil moved to approve and Ms. Rutz seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

- Workshop of May 13, 2008

Ms. Rutz moved to approve and Vice Chair Preil seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. City Entrance Signs for Highbanks and Enterprise

Chair McShea discussed the need for a sign on 17-92 for the River City Nature Park at Barwick Road. Mr. Gonzalez said he would contact DOT for getting one of the small brown identification signs.

Ms. Rutz said she would like the same City entrance sign used at that location as the other City signs. Chair McShea said that Alex Ford gave him permission to put a City sign on his property if the City clears the area, which is on the corner of Enterprise and Highbanks.

Vice Chair Preil suggested they do some site analysis before they go any further. Mr. Gonzalez said he would find out the right-of-way dimensions and the setbacks.

Chair McShea made a motion for the Committee to investigate the placement of a sign at Highbanks and Enterprise. Vice Chair Preil seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Bus Stops

Mr. Gonzalez stated that it has been difficult to find a manufacturer of the shelters discussed by the Committee at the last meeting. He asked the members if they agreed with allowing him to research a similar design and bring it back to the Committee. He also said he would investigate getting one custom made for the City. Vice Chair Preil said it would be nice to have something custom made that one could only find in DeBary.

6. Bike Lanes

Mr. Gonzalez said he checked with DOT, and bike lanes measure four feet wide.

Vice Chair Preil stated that DOT recently posted an advertisement looking for a consultant to perform a district-wide study on bike lanes.

7. Public Participation

Mayor Coleman informed the Committee that Votran has reduced their service, and has removed some of the bus stops on their route. He also noted that there is a vacancy on the MPO Citizens Advisory Committee. Mr. Gonzalez added that if anyone is interested, the Committee meets once per month.

Chair McShea suggested the Committee taking a vacation during the summer until September. Ms. Clark said she would be out of town in July and August. Ms. Rutz stated she would be out of town in August and September. Vice Chair Preil made a motion to hold the next meeting in October. Ms. Rutz seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
