

**STREETSCAPE ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING**

**MINUTES**

**1. Call to Order**

Chair Susan Preil called the meeting to order at 5:37 pm.

**2. Roll Call**

Present: Chair Susan Preil, Aileen McRae, Mike Arroyo, Mike Kolba and Laura Clark

Absent: Vice-Chair Barbara Rutz (excused) and Chris Beehner (excused)

Also Present: Acting City Manager Anthony Gonzalez

**3. Approval of Minutes**

- Meeting of May 12, 2009

Chair Preil entertained a motion for approval. Motion made by Mr. Kolba and seconded by Ms. McRae. The motion passed unanimously.

**4. Bus Stop Update**

Mr. Gonzalez said he spoke with Mr. Leonard from Spencer Fabrications; that he had been working in Miami; that he was still willing to work with the Committee; that he needs additional information from the Committee; and that he is asking for a Committee member to volunteer to work with Mr. Leonard.

Mr. Kolba volunteered to work with Mr. Leonard.

Chair Preil said she would forward the CAD file to Mr. Leonard.

Chair Preil gave the other members the grant report provided by Mr. Beehner, as he was unable to attend the meeting. He reported that he had contacted the Florida Public Transportation Association and VOTRAN, but he has not heard back from either one; that VOTRAN was recently awarded a million dollar grant from the stimulus package; that he is also contacting the Federal Transit Administration; and that he hopes to have additional information to provide to the Committee at the next meeting.

Mr. Kolba said he received a call from a friend at Volusia County, and the person told him that \$500,000 was just approved to be utilized for bus stops.

Mr. Kolba asked about the City Council's suggestion for a backdrop. Chair Preil responded that they could not incorporate the backdrop without significantly changing the design of the shelter.

Mr. Gonzalez informed the members that Council would hold their first budget workshop on Thursday, June 11<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. McRae said she could speak with a VOTRAN representative about the grant reported by Mr. Beehner.

Mr. Kolba said he would follow up with Mr. Leonard after Chair Preil sends him the CAD file.

Chair Preil noted that the Committee would have a chance to look at the shelter again before it goes to the structural engineer.

There was discussion regarding the number of bus stops in the City. Mr. Arroyo volunteered to drive around DeBary to get a firm number of bus stops.
