Subject: City Manager's Weekly Report

1. School Concurrency

Assistant City Manager Anthony Gonzalez attended the Volusia County School Concurrency Stakeholders meeting held May 11th. The Committee worked on the Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning and revisited the "Guiding Principles" for Volusia County Public Schools in order to address School Concurrency Service Areas (CSA) issues. Items discussed included school capacities, attending a school closest to a child's home, how school attendance boundaries for CSA's will be drawn, and how to meet all constitutional requirements.

2. Activities in DeBary

The DeBary Parks and Recreation Department will host the Mother - Son Dance for DeBary Elementary School students to be held Friday evening, May 11th, at Florence K. Little Town Hall.

3. Safety Coordinator

The HAM radio operators discussed HAM radio over the internet at the Monday morning meeting.

Safety Coordinator Alan Williamson attended the West Volusia Community Traffic Safety Team meeting. Discussion was held on various traffic problems around West Volusia and possible solutions. Educational programs and law enforcement programs such as Click it or Ticket, Seat Belt survey's, and Motorcycle Awareness were also discussed.

The Public Safety Advisory Committee met with discussions on pedestrian safety and accessibility to Gemini Springs Park; especially for the handicapped since there is not a sidewalk in place at the corner of Dirksen and 17-92. Discussion was also on tornado warning devices which included sirens and weather radios. Fire hydrants were also discussed and the possibility of expanding hydrant service on to the current water lines already in place.

Alan Williamson coordinated a CPR class and five residents have completed the CPR course.

Alan Williamson attended municipal liaison training at the County Emergency Operations Center. This year, training consisted of reviewing the 2007 Disaster Preparedness Guide, review of E-Team software, and a two-hour exercise to hone emergency management skills.
