**4. Safety Coordinator**

The HAM radio operators met for their weekly meeting. A member of the group formerly worked for a planetarium, and he gave a presentation on the types of telescopes and how they work. He also discussed different scientific exhibits and displays that he worked with.

The Basic CERT class met for their second training session. This week, the topic was fire suppression and fire safety. Students were taught the different classifications of fire, basic fire science, and fire

fighting safety. Students participated in a hands-on fire suppression drill by extinguishing a fire with a 5 lb. dry chemical extinguisher.

Safety Coordinator Alan Williamson attended a Division of Emergency Management training course on Point of Distribution Sites. The training session included pre-event planning, field sites, forward operations, support bases, county staging areas, staffing, and staffing responsibilities. The Course focused on how to pre-designate a site, how to set up distribution sites in the aftermath of a disaster, and how to safely run a distribution site.

## **5. Parks and Recreation Department**

The **Youth Outdoor Dodge Ball League** will continue game play on February 4, 2012 at Bill Keller Park. Games will be played according to a four-team game schedule each Saturday until March 3, 2012. The playoffs for all four teams will be held on March 10, 2012 with the championship game concluding the season on March 17, 2012.

The **Dance to Health** program continued classes on Thursday, February 2, 2012 for the morning and evening session at Florence K. Little Town Hall. More than one-hundred and thirty women over the age of 50 are signed up for this popular program. The Dance to Health program is instructed by volunteer Loie Polinsky.

The **Father/Daughter Dance** will be held on March 30, 2012 from 6-9pm at Florence K. Little Town Hall. Tickets will be made available starting March 1, 2012 at City Hall. Cost is \$10 per ticket. This program is designed for DeBary residents only. Girls must be in elementary school in order to attend. Two proofs of residency are required at time of purchase. Limited space is available!

Registration for the **2012 Youth Flag Football League** designed for boys & girls ages 6-11 will be held from March 5, 2012-March 16, 2012 at City Hall. Cost is \$50. Practices begin the week of March 26, 2012 with game play starting April 13-14, 2012. All games and practices will be held at Rob Sullivan Community Park. Volunteer coaches are needed in both age divisions. Coaches must be approved by the City of DeBary prior to the start of practice.

The **2012 Youth Tennis Clinic** for boys & girls ages 3-5 will be held on Wednesdays from April 18, 2012-May 23, 2012 at Bill Keller Park tennis courts. Session I for boys & girls age 3 will be held from 4:15pm-5:00pm, Session II for boys & girls age 4 will be held from 5:00pm-6:00pm and Session III for boys & girls age 5 will be held from 6:00pm-7:00pm. Registration will be from March 19, 2012-March 30, 2012 at City Hall. Cost is \$25 per child.

Planning continues for the start of a **Girls Tennis Program** for ages 6-13. Classes are tentatively scheduled to be held on Tuesday or Thursday evening based on age from April 3, 2012- June 21, 2012 (12 classes). Tuesday classes will be held from 5:30pm-6:30pm (ages 6/7) and 6:30pm-7:30pm (ages 8/9). Thursday classes will be held from 5:30pm-6:30pm (ages 10/11) and 6:30pm-7:30pm (ages 12/13). Times are subject to change based on total number of registrations. Limited spaces are available. Participants must provide their own racket. Registration will be held March 5, 2012-March 16, 2012 at City Hall. Cost is \$50 per child. All classes will be held at the Bill Keller Park tennis courts.

Planning continues for the **2012 Summer Day Camp** scheduled for June 11, 2012-August 3, 2012 (8 weeks) at Florence K. Little Town Hall. This program is designed for boys & girls entering 2<sup>nd</sup> grade through entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Registration will begin for DeBary residents on April 2, 2012. Registration for returning campers who attended at least 6 weeks of camp in 2011 will begin on April 5, 2012. Registration for non-residents will begin on April 9, 2012 until filled. Registrants are only guaranteed spots paid for in advance. Cost is \$80 per week and includes cost of field trips, registration fees and two program t-shirts. Additional costs vary from \$5-\$15 per field trip attending to cover cost of food/snacks or extra game tokens. Counselor positions for the 2012 Summer Camp have been filled. There are no open positions at this time.

The City of DeBary Parks & Recreation Department is excited to announce the start of the Counselor-in-Training Program. This is a volunteer program for boys & girls ages 13-15. One young person will be selected each summer to learn basic counselor techniques and assist with the summer camp program. The program description is available at City Hall. Applications and questionnaires will be made available on February 1, 2012. A C.I.T. for the 2012 Summer Camp will be selected by April 27, 2012.

The **2012 Fun N Games Camp** for boys & girls entering 2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade will be held from August 6, 2012-August 17, 2012 at Florence K. Little Town Hall. This program will take the place of the Summer Movie Program offered in years past and will cover the remaining weeks of summer vacation prior to the start of school. Cost is \$60 per week. Boys & girls registered for this program will participate in a variety of fun arts & crafts projects, games, activities and so much more. Each day will consist of at least one movie and a walk to Power Park.
